12 Months ahead

- ♦ Decide on a budget

- ♦ Hire wedding consultant (optional)
- ♦ Select bridal party

6 - 9 Months ahead

4 – 6 Months ahead

1 - 2 Months ahead

- ♦ Call county clerk's office for marriage license details, schedule date to obtain
- ♦ Mail invitations
- ♦ Arrange for final gown fittings
- ♦ Make reservations for bridesmaids luncheon
- ♦ Confirm honeymoon arrangements
- ♦ Prepare printed programs for ceremony
- ♦ Start reception seating chart
- Purchase wedding accessories (guest book and pen, unity candle, toasting glasses, cake knife and server, flower girl and ring bearer accessories
- ♦ Develop wedding day timeline
- ♦ Buy or borrow accessories (shoes, jewelry, tie, etc.)

2 - 4 Weeks ahead

- ♦ Arrange for professionals to preserve your gown and bouquet
- ♦ Follow up on missing RSVPS and complete seating chart and place cards
- ♦ Confirm final guest count with caterer/venue
- ♦ Write rehearsal dinner and wedding toasts
- ♦ Purchase alcohol if BYOB
- ◊ Pack emergency wedding kit
- ♦ Print programs and menus
- ♦ Final dress fittings
- ♦ Hair and make-up trials

1 Week ahead

- ♦ Final consultations with caterer/venue, florist, DJ/ musicians, photographer
- ♦ Host bridesmaid luncheon
- ♦ Begin packing for wedding night and honeymoon
- ♦ Confirm timing with all vendors

Sharing The Cost

It is no longer expected that the wedding costs will be assigned according to tradition. Discuss your plan and budget with your families to determine whether or not to follow a traditional division of financial responsibility for the wedding costs. If circumstances don't allow the families to follow tradition, the proper rationale in deciding who pays for what portion is basic: whoever is the most willing and most able to pay for a wedding expense assumes responsibility for that expense.

Terminology

- ♦ Boutonniere- Single flower for men worn on lapel
- ♦ Corsage- Single flower for women worn on wrist or pinned to dress
- ♦ Cascade- Blossoms & greenery in teardrop shape
- ♦ Hand tied- Cut flowers with ribbon or fabric, carried
- ♦ Nosegay- Single flower or small bouquet-, carried
- ♦ Pomander- Round bouquet on a cord usually for flower girls
- ♦ Spray- Small bunch of gathered flowers, carried
- \Diamond Toss bouquet-Bouquet or flower thrown to the bridesmaids and bachelorettes
